Phear Park cafe: Lib Dem Councillors were alerted to the early closure of the cafe in September 2018. They have raised the matter with the Chief Executive of East Devon District Council (EDDC) and asked for the cafe/golf course and dog area to be re opened by this coming Easter. EDDC went out to tender and are at present in negotiations regarding rental agreements.
