Flood Defence

Alarmed at the delayed Tidal Defence Scheme works, veteran campaigner Eileen Wragg raised her concerns, resulting in the UK Environment Agency Chairman visiting Exmouth.

'He saw the changes to the coast at first hand.' said Eileen. 'Thankfully the works have now started, to the relief of hundreds of residents in the Colony and Seafront areas, whose homes will be protected from flooding'.
